- 1 DAVID BOWIE (famously sang "The Little Drummer Boy" with Bing Crosby)
- 2 ANNIE LENNOX (born on Christmas Day, 1954)
- 3 HUMPHREY BOGART (born on Christmas Day, 1899)
- 4 BOB GELDOF (creator of Band Aid and co-wrote the song "Do They Know It's Christmas?")
- 5 DAWN FRENCH (famous as the fairy in the Christmas M&S advert and *The Vicar of Dibley*)
- 6 WILLIAM THE CONQUEROR (crowned on the 25th December, 1066 at Westminster Abbey)
- 7 CHRISTOPHER BIGGINS (famously appeared in pantomime every year since 1965)
- 8 CHARLES DICKENS (author of the 1843 novel 'A Christmas Carol')
- 9 PAUL HOGAN (star of 'Crocodile Dundee', the single most-viewed Christmas Day film in the UK)
- 10 BRUCE WILLIS (star of 'Die Hard', often named one of the best Christmas films)
- 11 The Real DICK WHITTINGTON (medieval London Mayor; his story is told today in pantomime)
- 12 RUDYARD KIPLING (wrote the first Christmas Day message by a British monarch in 1932)
- 13 MARIAH CAREY (famous for singing 'All I Want for Christmas Is You')
- 14 BING CROSBY (famously sang "White Christmas")
- 15 JOANNA PAGE (actress who plays Stacey in the *Gavin & Stacey* Christmas Day 2019 special)
- 16 DANNY KAYE (one of the main actors in the 1954 film *White Christmas*)
- 17 NICOLE KIDMAN (A UK Christmas Number 1 in 2001 with Robbie Williams)
- 18 DR. SEUSS (author of 'How the Grinch Stole Christmas')
- 19 JUDY GARLAND (star of the 1939 film 'The Wizard of Oz')
- 20 LEONA LEWIS (Christmas Number 1 in 2006 with 'A Moment Like This')
